Obama officials face grand jury probe over 2016 Russia intel allegations

WASHINGTON : (AGENCY)

US Attorney General Pam Bondi has directed federal prosecutors to launch a grand jury investigation into allegations that members of Democratic former president Barack Obama's administration manufactured intelligence on Russia's interference in the 2016 elections, a source familiar with the matter said on Monday. The Justice Department said late last month it was forming a strike force to assess claims made by Director of National Intelligence Tulsi Gabbard about "alleged weaponisation of the US intelligence community." Republican US President Donald Trump has leaped on comments from Gabbard in which she threatened to refer Obama administration officials to the Justice Department for prosecution over an intelligence assessment of Russian interference. Fox News first reported that Bondi per-



sonally ordered an unnamed federal prosecutor to initiate legal proceedings and the prosecutor is expected to present department evidence to a grand jury, which could consider an indictment if the Justice Department pursued a criminal case. The report cited a letter from Bondi and a source. A DOJ spokesperson declined to comment. Referring to the probe in a post on Truth Social, Trump said: "The TRUTH always wins out. This is great news." Last month, Trump accused Obama of treason, alleging, without providing evidence, that the Democrat

led an effort to falsely, him to Russia and undermine his 2016 presidential campaign. Trump won the 2016 election against Democrat Hillary Clinton. A spokesperson for Obama had denounced Trump's claims, saying "these bizarre allegations are ridiculous and a weak attempt at distraction." Gabbard had declassified documents and said the information she released showed a "treasonous conspiracy" in 2016 by top Obama officials to undermine Trump, claims that Democrats called false and politically motivated. An assessment by the US intelligence community published in January 2017 concluded that Russia, using social media disinformation, hacking, and Russian bot farms, sought to damage Clinton's 2016 presidential campaign and bolster Trump, who won that election. The assessment determined the actual impact.

Bangladesh begins celebrations of uprising anniversary amid high security

DHAKA. (AGENCY)

Thousands of people on Tuesday started to gather at Manik Mia Avenue, a major street in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka, that forms the south boundary of the National Parliament House Complex, to celebrate the first uprising day, the one-year anniversary of the overthrow of the previous Sheikh Hasina government, amid high security. The interim government of the South Asian country of 170 million people have organised the mega-event after declaring the day a national holiday.



The government has arranged to bring people from all over the country to this event by hiring eight pairs of trains. Garment factories have been closed so that workers can also attend the event. Officials of various banks have also been asked to attend the event. The day-long festival kicked off with a performance by the country's major musical bands and popular cultural artists. Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus is expected to unveil formally the 'July declaration', an official declaration of the July Mass Uprising of 2024 in Bangladesh, later today. The declaration reportedly outlines 26 political, constitutional and governance issues. He will also address the nation this evening via state radio and television. Various political parties have organised various programs. Jamat-E-Islami, the largest Islamic

um, liberating our beloved nation from the grip of long-standing fascist rule", Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus said in a message. "The interim government is committed to restoring the state power to the people through a peaceful, fair, and transparent election, as part of a sustainable political solution", he added. However, Human Rights Watch (HRW) criticised the interim Bangladesh government of Mohammad Yunus for falling short in implementing.

Trump fires labour official ; weak job numbers were rigged, claims President

PARIS : (AGENCY)

President Donald Trump unleashed his fury about weakness in the labour market on Friday, saying without evidence that the data were "rigged" and that he was firing the Senate-confirmed department of labour official responsible for pulling together the numbers each month. In a long post on social media, Trump said he had directed his team to fire Erika McEntarfer, the commissioner of the Bureau of Labour Statistics, who was confirmed on a bipartisan basis in 2024.



Emily Liddel, an associate commissioner for the bureau, confirmed late on Friday that Dr McEntarfer had been fired and that William Wiatrowski, the deputy commissioner, would serve as acting commissioner. The President fired Dr McEntarfer after the bureau released monthly jobs data showing surprisingly weak hiring in July and large downward revisions to job growth in the previous two months. Economists widely interpreted the report as evidence that Trump's policies were beginning to take a toll

on the economy, though the President insisted in a subsequent post that the country was "doing GREAT!"

Lori Chavez-DeRemer, the labour secretary, echoed Trump's concerns about Dr McEntarfer in a post on social media. "So you know what I did?" Trump later told reporters, as he claimed the numbers were "phony." "I fired her, and you know what? I did the right thing," Dr McEntarfer was appointed to her post by President Joseph R. Biden Jr. in 2023 after a long career at the Census Bureau and other agencies, where she served under Presidents of both parties, including Trump. Among the Republicans who voted to confirm her as

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commissioner was Vice-President J.D. Vance, who was then an Ohio senator. The firing prompted swift criticism from economists, former government officials and others, who said the removal would further erode trust in government statistics and make it more difficult for policymakers, investors and businesses, who rely on having depend-

able data about the economy to make decisions. In addition to the monthly jobs numbers, the Bureau of Labour Statistics is responsible for producing data on inflation, wages and other aspects of the economy.

William W. Beach, who led the bureau during Trump's first term, criticised the move to fire Dr McEntarfer on Friday. "It's unfortunate," he said. "This could set a precedent where bad news on many different fronts is a reason for dismissing a person." Beach, who was appointed by Trump in 2019 and remained in the role for the first two years of the Biden administration, said he had never felt pressure to manipulate the data under either President.

UAE aid ship 'Khalifa' arrives in Al Arish Port

AL ARISH. (AGENCY) The eighth UAE aid ship, Khalifa, reached Al Arish Port in Egypt on Tuesday as part of "Operation Chivalrous Knight 3," in preparation for delivering its cargo to the Gaza Strip, in continuation of the UAE's humanitarian support for the Palestinian people. The ship was received by a delegation of representatives from humanitarian and charitable organisations, along with Ahmed Sari Al Mazrouei, Secretary-General of the Emirates Red Crescent (ERC), and Egyptian officials.

Canada conducts first humanitarian airdrop in Gaza

OTTAWA. (AGENCY) The Canadian Armed Forces made their first humanitarian airdrop over Gaza on Monday using their own aircraft delivering 9,800 kilograms of aid to Palestinians, according to Global Affairs Canada, as reported by CBC News. CBC News had exclusive access to the Canadian effort, which delivered food supplies like lentils, oil, milk powder and pasta using a C-130J Hercules aircraft that departed from a Jordanian airbase.

Rapper Sean 'Diddy' Combs loses bid to get out of jail prior to sentencing

NEW YORK. (AGENCY) Sean "Diddy" Combs on Monday lost his bid to be released from jail ahead of his October 3 sentencing, despite a jury having found the hip-hop mogul not guilty of the most serious charges at his sex crimes trial. Combs' lawyers had asked US District Judge Arun Subramanian on July 29 to release Combs on \$50 million bond, saying conditions at the Metropolitan Detention Center in Brooklyn were dangerous and other defendants convicted of prostitution-related charges similar to Combs' were usually released before sentencing. In a written ruling, the judge said Combs' arguments "might have traction in a case that didn't involve evidence of violence, coercion or subjugation in connection."

बिहार में शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य और परिवहन क्षेत्र में बड़े फैसले :

शिक्षक भर्ती में डोमिसाइल लागू, रात्रि प्रहरी-रसोइयों का वेतन बढ़ा, नई योजनाओं को मंजूरी

पटना (एजेंसी)

बिहार सरकार ने मंगलवार को कई अहम फैसलों को मंजूरी दी, जिनका सीधा असर राज्य के शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य और परिवहन क्षेत्रों पर पड़ेगा। मंत्रिपरिषद की बैठक में लिए गए इन निर्णयों के तहत एक ओर जहां शिक्षक भर्ती में राज्य के अर्थाथियों को प्राथमिकता दी जाएगी, वहीं दूसरी ओर विभिन्न योजनाओं के तहत वेतन वृद्धि और नई सुविधाएं भी लागू होंगी। ‘बिहार राज्य विद्यालय अध्यापक (नियुक्ति, स्थानांतरण, अनुशासनिक कार्रवाई और सेवा शर्त) नियमावली 2025’ में संशोधन कर राज्य के अर्थाथियों को अधिक अवसर देने का निर्णय लिया गया है। अब जिन उम्मीदवारों ने बिहार से मैट्रिक और इंटर की परीक्षा दी है, उन्हें स्कूल

शिक्षक भर्ती और अन्य बहालियों में प्राथमिकता मिलेगी। जिन स्कूलों में लैब, कंप्यूटर या खेल सामग्री उपलब्ध है, वहाँ कार्यरत रात्रि प्रहरीयों का वेतन बढ़ा दिया गया है।मध्याह्न भोजन योजना में काम करने वाली रसोइया-सह-सहायकों का मासिक मानदेय 1,650 रुपये से बढ़कर 3,300 रुपये कर दिया गया है। मध्य विद्यालयों में पार्ट-टाइम शारीरिक शिक्षा और स्वास्थ्य अनुदेशकों को अब 8,000 रुपये की जगह 16,000 रुपये महीना मिलेगा। साथ ही उनकी वार्षिक वेतनवृद्धि 200 रुपये से बढ़कर 400 रुपये कर दी गई है। मुख्यमंत्री किशोरी स्वास्थ्य योजना: 7वीं से 12वीं तक की छात्राओं को DBT के जरिए लाभ, 1 अप्रैल से 31 जुलाई 2025 तक 75% उपस्थिति जरूरी।



मुख्यमंत्री छात्रवृत्ति योजना : 9वीं-10वीं के छात्र-छात्राओं को DBT से आर्थिक मदद, 75% उपस्थिति अनिवार्य। मुख्यमंत्री साईकिल योजना: 9वीं के छात्रों को DBT से राशि, 75% उपस्थिति पर। मुख्यमंत्री बालिका पोशाक योजना: 9वीं से 12वीं तक की छात्राओं को

कपड़ों के लिए DBT से राशि, 75% उपस्थिति की शर्त। मुंगेर विश्वविद्यालय में 151 पुराने पद खत्म कर 167 नए पद सृजित किए जाएंगे। साथ ही 20 नए पीजी विभाग भी खोले जाएंगे। आशा कार्यकर्ताओं और आशा फैसिलिटेटरों का मासिक मानदेय 1,000 रुपये से बढ़कर 3,000

रुपये किया गया। ‘ममता’ कार्यकर्ताओं को प्रति प्रसव प्रोत्साहन राशि 300 रुपये से बढ़कर 600 रुपये कर दी गई। राज्य के हर विधानसभा क्षेत्र में डिजिटल लाइब्रेरी सेंटर स्थापित किए जाएंगे। 94 करोड़ 50 लाख 47 हजार रुपये की स्वीकृति दी गई है। 10 कंप्यूटर, हार्ड-स्पीड इंटरनेट, बिजली सुविधा कम से कम 300 वर्गफुट का कमरा JEE, NEET, CLAT समेत प्रतियोगी

परीक्षाओं की ऑनलाइन तैयारी नौकरी से जुड़ी जानकारी और प्रशिक्षण **परिवहन विभाग की नई योजना** अंतर्राज्यीय रूटों पर 200 एसी और नॉन-एसी बसें चलाई जाएंगी, जिन्हें निजी ऑपरेटर संचालित करेंगे। पीक टाइम पर सरकार प्रति सीट 150 रेंगी। यह योजना 5 साल चलेगी, जिसके लिए 36.35 करोड़ मंजूर किए गए हैं। वर्ष 2025-26 में संचालन के लिए 7.27 करोड़ बिहार आकस्मिकता निधि से दिए जाएंगे।

राहुल गांधी और तेजस्वी यादव चुनाव आयोग को बदनाम कर रहे हैं : संजय जायसवाल

बिहार में मतदाता सूची को लेकर चल रहे विवाद के बीच बीजेपी सांसद संजय जायसवाल ने कांग्रेस नेता राहुल गांधी और आरजेडी नेता तेजस्वी यादव पर तीखा हमला बोला। बातचीत में उन्होंने दोनों नेताओं पर चुनाव आयोग को बदनाम करने और जनता को गुमराह करने का आरोप लगाते हुए कहा कि यह लोकतंत्र के साथ मजाक है। संजय जायसवाल ने कहा कि तेजस्वी यादव ने स्वयं स्वीकार किया कि उनके पास दो वोटर आईडी कार्ड हैं। उन्होंने सांसद पप्पू यादव का जिक्र करते हुए कहा कि उनके पास भी दो वोटर आईडी होने की बात सामने आई है। आरजेडी कार्यकर्ता फर्जी वोटर आईडी बनाना बंद करें और मौजूदा फर्जी कार्ड सरेंड़ करें। तेजस्वी जैसे नेता तो बच जाएंगे,



लेकिन कार्यकर्ताओं को भविष्य में नुकसान उठाना पड़ सकता है। भारत में हर नागरिक को सिर्फ एक वोट का अधिकार है और लोकतंत्र में फर्जीवाड़ा बर्दाश्त नहीं किया जाएगा। उन्होंने राहुल गांधी और तेजस्वी यादव की प्रस्तावित ‘मतदाता अधिकार यात्रा’ पर तंज कसते हुए कहा कि दोनों नेता बिहार में आगामी विधानसभा चुनाव में हार के डर से जनता को भटकाने की कोशिश कर रहे हैं। विपक्ष के पास कोई ठोस मुद्दा नहीं है, इसलिए वे संवैधानिक संस्था जैसे चुनाव आयोग पर सवाल उठा रहे हैं।

नीतीश कुमार ने बिहार को अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर पर स्थापित किया : नीरज कुमार

जनता दल यूनाइटेड (जेडीयू) प्रवक्ता नीरज कुमार ने बिहार के मुख्यमंत्री नीतीश कुमार की उपलब्धियों को रेखांकित करते हुए विपक्ष पर जमकर निशाना साधा। उन्होंने कहा कि नीतीश कुमार घोषणाओं के बजाय निश्चय के लिए जाने जाते हैं और बिहार की पहचान को अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर पर स्थापित किया है। नालंदा अंतरराष्ट्रीय विश्वविद्यालय में 22 देशों के छात्र पढ़ रहे हैं, जो इसकी मिसाल हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि तेजस्वी यादव के परिवार ने सिर्फ 33,000 शिक्षकों की नियुक्ति की, जबकि नीतीश सरकार ने 6 लाख शिक्षकों को नौकरी दी।



एस्टेटीइटी परीक्षा की तैयारी के लिए भी कदम उठाए गए हैं। यह बिना भ्रष्टाचार और जमीन के सौदों के रोजगार देने का अनूठा मॉडल है, जो देश के लिए मिसाल बना है। प्राथमिक शिक्षा में बिहार नंबर वन है, फिर भी किसी दल ने आपत्ति नहीं जताई। उन्होंने लोकतंत्र के लिए चिंता जताते हुए कहा कि हर दल को बूथ लेवल

एजेंट (बीएलए) नियुक्त करना था, लेकिन बिहार में कोई भी दल इसमें सफल नहीं रहा। विशेष रूप से प्रशांत किशोर की टीम ने एक भी बीएलए नियुक्त नहीं किया, जो उनकी कमजोरी को दर्शाता है। अनिल अंबानी प्रकरण को लेकर ईडी की जांच पर नीरज कुमार ने कहा कि अगर आर्थिक गड़बड़ाइयां पाई गईं, तो यह ईडी के अधिकार क्षेत्र में है। जांच एजेंसी पूरे मामले की तपतीश करेगी। अब इस पूरे मामले में आगे क्या कुछ करना है, ये तो ईडी ही बता पाएगी। वहीं, उन्होंने सुप्रीम कोर्ट की राहुल गांधी पर टिप्पणी का जिक्र करते
